INTRODUCING LUKE

A movement to revive urban Chicago

By God's grace and because of what other churches are seeing Him do through the Life Spring Network, we have been commissioned to lead a movement within five Lutheran Congregations in urban Chicago. Please see the official press release below.

In an effort to revitalize existing congregations and create new missional ministries in the Chicago area, the Clarence and Marilyn Schawk Foundation has provided a grant to form LUKE (Lutheran Urban Kingdom Expansion) Ministries, a Chicago based urban ministry renewal initiative.

This exciting, Spirit-led ministry is a pilot and collaborative effort of the Chicagoland Lutheran Educational Foundation (CLEF), the Northern Illinois District (NID), the Life Spring Network (LSN), and Trinity Lutheran Church in Roselle. The Mission of LUKE is:

To partner with Lutheran congregations in urban Chicago and unite them together toward building holistic, transformational disciple-making communities who are living on mission with God through Word and Sacrament ministry.

As urban ministry catalysts, each of the partners is committed to using their unique skills and experiences in providing support, resources, leadership, mentoring, communication, coordination and training, while living in the Spirit and following the Spirit's leading in all they do. The command to "Go and make disciples" is as relevant and as necessary today as when it was first issued by our Lord.

These churches used to be the spiritual and relational anchors of their communities and are now barely hanging on. We have begun the LUKE Ministries Chicago project to reverse this trend and serve as a model of urban renewal. We will begin working with five congregations over the next five years and expand into more congregations as God leads. In order to fulfill this mission, we have already begun to expand our staff here at LSN.

THREE YEARS TO FIVE HUNDRED

Introducing our three-year plan to touch 500 Churches by the 500 year anniversary of the Reformation



October 31, 1517 Rev. Dr. Martin Luther began the Reformation of the church. We are feeling led by God to set a BHAG (Big Hairy Audacious Goal) for LSN. A goal that only God could achieve. We are prayerfully seeking to have *500* churches exposed to the ministry of LSN, *500* people attending the Disciple-Making Summit, *50* churches using our resources and *10* churches using the Omega Experience as their disciple-making masterplan by October 31, 2017. We are convicted that the church is in need of a new reformation in disciple-making and we believe God has raised up LSN for such a time as this.

Three-Year Fundraising Goal

With the favor that we are experiencing and the clear direction that the Lord is giving us, we are looking for people to partner with us for this three year plan. We are amazed at the progress the Lord has made in our ministry financially. When the ministry began in 2006, we had to raise roughly \$300,000 per year. Now, with the income we receive from consulting, resources sales, speaking and mentoring, we estimate that we will need \$150,000 per year over the next three years to accomplish these goals.

UPDATE: PARTNERING WITH TRINITY LUTHERAN CHURCH

For the past five years, we have partnered with Trinity Lutheran Church in Roselle, IL to help them grow as a disciple-making community. Jason has committed two to three days a week to training, mentoring and equipping its leaders. By God's grace, we are seeing this 100 year old, 4000 member strong church known for worship, teaching and serving its community transform into a holistic, transformational, disciple-making church. We are still on the journey together, but God has made tremendous progress in our midst, so much so that Trinity is now sharing the transformational journey of the Omega Experience with other church leaders around the world through hosting the annual Disciple-Making Summit. This is an expanded version of a two-day conference we held in June of 2013. That year, we had 40 people in attendance representing six churches. This year, over 120 people were in attendance representing over 25 churches.
